School Meals

As you are aware, under the national Universal Infant Free School Meals Initiative, children have an automatic entitlement to a free school meal until the end of Year 2.

Notice for Parents of Children in Year 3 from September 2017 – Free School Meals

Automatic entitlement to a free school meal finishes at the end of Year 2 and only children from **low income families** are eligible from Year 3.

If you household income is less than £16,190 per year, or you receive Income Support or an equivalent benefit, you will need to make an application in August if you want your child to receive a free school meal from September.
